For more than 35 years, people of faith and others concerned about the ongoing proliferation of nuclear weapons have gathered on Good Friday outside the Livermore Laboratory. We strive for the healing of all nations. We envision and work for repair, reconciliation, restoration, transformation.

The Good Friday witness at the Livermore Labs has been held every year since 1983. This year we will celebrate the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons. Our preacher will be Rev. Michael Yoshii. Betsy Rose will give us music. Carla De Sola brings to us liturgical dance. Marylia Kelley will tell us what the lab is doing to design nuclear weapons. Jackie Cabasso will speak on how we can work to make the prohibition of nuclear weapons the world-wide standard and how to hold our country to that standard. Our preacher, our scripture, our dance, our music and our prayers will raise in our hearts and spirits the dedication to indeed beat our swords into plowshares.
