

Good Friday this year falls on the day before the anniversary of Dr. King's Beyond Vietnam speech in which he spoke clearly against the U.S. war against Vietnam. Dr. King called upon us to oppose "the giant triplets of racism, materialism and militarism." He said, "A true revolution of values will soon look uneasily on the glaring contrast of poverty and wealth." Good Friday is also the day before the anniversary of Dr. King's assassination. David Hartsough met Martin Luther King during the Montgomery bus boycott in 1956 and has been active in civil rights, peace and anti-nuclear movements since the 1950s. He is a Quaker, Director of Peaceworkers (peaceworkersus.org) and is the author of the newly published book, Waging Peace: Global Adventures of a Lifelong Activist.
