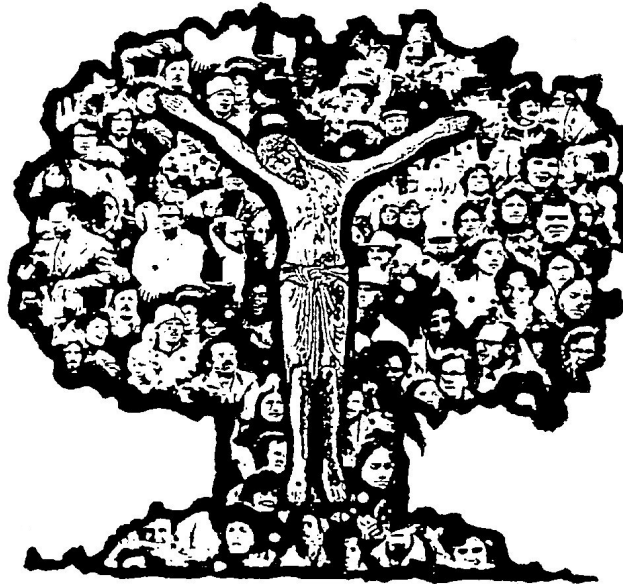
Dr. King and the Cloud

Opening music 6:45 a.m.

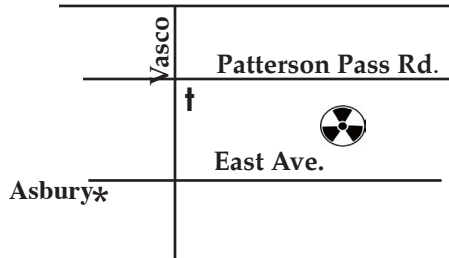
Worship 7:00 a.m. followed by procession to the gate,
